#### Water UK Standards Board Strategy: Lead

## 1. Purpose of this document

This document has been developed by the Water UK Standards Board (WSB) in response to the presence of lead in drinking water and any subsequent changes in concentration values as specified in the Drinking Water Directive (DWD). The aim is to achieve sustainable reductions in lead levels as part of a long-term transition to its elimination in drinking water supplies. This will be supported by ensuring appropriate international (ISO), European (EN), and British (BS) standards – and, if necessary, Water Industry Standards (WIS) or Industry Guidance Notes (IGN) – are in place.

#### 2. Key Standards
