Water UK Standards Board Strategy: Sustainable Sludge Management

1. Purpose of this document

This document has been developed by the Water UK Standards Board (WSB) to ensure that the appropriate international (ISO), European (CEN), and British (BS) – and, if necessary, Water Industry Standards (WIS) or Industry Guidance Notes (IGN) - are in place to support the continued and uninterrupted treatment and reuse of sludge biosolids by the UK water industry.

2. Key Standards

The key outcomes within this area are to understand the need for any standards associated with Sustainable Sludge Management arising from the UK Water industry's operation. This is a developing area for standards with innovation in sludge treatment methods in response to environmental targets, DEFRA's safe sludge matrix, PFAS and public views.
